CMI's Chinese customers include some of the world's largest technology, cloud and internet service providers (ISPs). A key part of the company's offering is helping its customers extend their services to new markets where CMI has a local data centre operation.

With its large and technologically mobile population, Japan has become a key target market for many of CMI's Chinese customers. Local corporations in Japan are also constantly seeking competitive telecom services to connect with their customer bases.







Challenge

CMI needed a local data centre operator that could help it quickly establish telecommunications services in Japan. Yet it also needed a facility with room for it to quickly scale up and expand its operations rapidly as needed – something traditional colocation data centres did not provide.

That's where Colt DCS's hyperscale capabilities came in. Colt DCS's Inzai 3 hyperscale data centre, based in Tokyo, provided the capacity and room for growth that CMI needed to expand into the Japanese market.

CMI purchased a large infrastructural requirement at the site, and the new Inzai 3 colocation will be ready in Q3 2021.

The partnership with Colt DCS has empowered CMI to keep pace with its ever-changing customer requirements. It has enabled them to reach out to new customers and extend their service offering more generally into professional support, cabling, maintenance, e-consulting and other telco services.

Colt DCS's Tokyo Inzai 3 data centre is one of the most secure, high-specification hyperscale data centres in the country. By adopting the latest energy-saving facilities and technologies, Inzai 3 delivers a high-density but cost-effective computing environment. It meets customer demands for efficient use of electrical power and cooling facilities, and generates an annual power usage effectiveness score of 1.5 or less.

Upon completion, Inzai 3 will offer a 27MW facility with 8,000 sqm of server space. Its data halls will be 1,000sqm each, in response to growing customer demands for more space for higher density computing. Inzai 3 offers 3.375kW per sqm.

CMI has acquired a data hall of 500m² for its equipment and servers, with a total power density of approximately 1.65MW. The security system protecting the hall is tailor-made, comprising a CCTV design system and diverse dark fibers linking back to the existing Inzai.

One of the major principles of hyperscale is in allowing customers complete control over their rackspace, with the ability to scale up and down capacity and purchase more space as required. At Inzai 3, CMI will have the agility to adapt its server estate in line with customer requirements.

The data centre is based across six floors, with a floor dedicated to storage, electrical and HVAC (heating, ventilation and air conditioning) resources, as well as a mezzanine floor for offices and workspaces. CMI personnel are actively working at the facility, where they have immediate access to Colt DCS's highly-skilled, bi-lingual staff to help manage its facilities.
